

WHAT IS A COOPERATIVE?

As a cooperative school, WCK fosters parent involvement within the classrooms as well as the management of the school. Parents are given the opportunity to contribute to policies and programming direction through participating in General Membership meetings and voting on school by-laws.

Parents rotate into the Nursery and Pre-Kindergarten classrooms as an extra pair of hands to assist the teacher in the program which their child is enrolled. These times are scheduled in advance and parents may specify which days work best for them.

Parents may also serve in volunteer roles for the general running of the school such as on the Executive Board as well as individual and committee positions. These positions allow parents the opportunity to watch their child grow, engage with other children and connect with families in the community.

GENERAL CURRICULUM

Enrollment

Registration for enrollment is held annually, usually in January, for the following school year. Order of placement for classes is current students/families, alumni families and general public.

A lottery will be held if demand exceeds space and your child must turn the required age by September 1st. A non-refundable registration fee is due and payable at the time of registration.

- Child must be 4 years old by September 30th
- Class Size: 16
- Lead Teacher, Assistant Teacher and Parent Volunteer

PRE-SCHOOL ENRICHMENT (PEEP)

- Class runs 11:30 AM to 1:45 PM
- 1 to 5 day programs available
- Compliments Nursery and Pre-K curriculum
- Class size: 16
- Lead Teacher and Assistant Teacher
