WHEN IS PEEP?

Peep is offered Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday after our morning classes. Children have the opportunity to eat lunch and participate in different enrichment activities each day from 11:30 to 1:45. The program is offered one to four days of choice a week.

PEEP CURRICULUM

PEEP IS EXCITING! PEEP takes the concepts and skills that children are learning in Nursery and Pre-K and expands on them.

Children are exposed to these themes plus more:

- Magnets
- Colors
- 5 senses
- Gravity
- Experimenting with different substances
- Birds and their habitats
- Investigating snow and its properties
- Healthy eating habits
- Cooking with literature
- Obstacle courses
- Singing games
- Parachute play
- Yoga poses



DAILY SCHEDULE

Below is a sample daily routine for a typical PEEP afternoon:

- 11:30 Recess
- 11:45 Lunch
- 12:15 Themed Activity (science, nature, gross motor, literacy and healthy cooking)
- 1:30 Outside play
- 1:45 Dismissal

ENROLLMENT

Registration for enrollment is held annually, usually in January, for the following school year. Order of placement for classes is current students/families, alumni families and general public.

Registering in January will hold your child's spot and day preference. A non-refundable registration fee is due with application.
